Andy Wareham (B. 1994) is a young composer and conductor from Southampton, England. His musical journey began at the age of six under the tuition of Lesley Milam and ever since then he has aspired to become an accomplished composer of music. He has become a keen academic and conductor within the Welsh and English brass band movements.



As a composer, Andy is published with a range of publishing houses and has had his music featured on BBC Radio and Television. He has won a number of awards for his music including the 'Vivendi Composition Award', 'Best Student Composition' at the 2016 University Brass Band Championships of Great Britain, The Cory Band's Composition Competition 2017 and A4 Brass Quartet's Composition Competition 2019.

Andy currently holds the position of 'Young Composer in Residence' with the world famous Black Dyke Band and is currently working under the mentorship of Black Dyke's renowned Composer in Association Professor Philip Wilby.

After graduating from Cardiff University as a Bachelor of Music (Hons), Andy went on to study as a Master of Music (Hons) at the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama. He was the first student in the college's history accepted to study on their Brass Band Conducting course and studied under the guidance of euphonium virtuoso and conductor Dr Robert Childs. Following two years of conducting the RWCMD Brass Band he graduated in July 2018 and directed the conservatoire's brass band one final time at his own graduation ceremony.



THE WOLF THAT SHALL BREAK IT

"Now this is the law of the jungle, as old and as true as the sky, and the wolf that shall keep it may prosper, but the **wolf that shall break it** must die."

'The Wolf that Shall Break it' was commissioned by Ocean Brass Band for their jungle-themed entertainment set at the Wychavon Festival of Brass 2019.

The work takes its name from Rudyard Kipling's poem '**The Law of the Jungle**'. The poem's form is a set of nineteen edicts depicting the laws of the animal kingdom from the perspective of the wolf.

The 'Law of the Jungle' is a common expression used for describing the mechanism of natural selection: the Darwinian principle that those beings who are strong and apply ruthless self-interest will be most successful. Although this evolution process can seem brutal and unforgiving through a human lens, the harsh reality of the natural order produces stronger, more adapted generations of life.

This constant struggle for survival is the basis for this work. The music aims to capture the beauty of the animal kingdom along with its contrasting brutal and violent nature.

The opening features slow, lyrical brass underpinned by a driving, primal percussion section. A middle section showcases the band's soloists before we return to the original musical material. The final section gradually builds in tension to our climax before the piece finishes as it began with the drum kit.

The music itself takes inspiration from a number of sources but most notably draws upon the music of avant-garde jazz group '*Mammal Hands*'.



The band set up in a flared formation with cornets stood. The drum kit was set up at the centre of the band and the baritones and euphoniums were swapped due to movement remaining in the rest of the set.

Two 'solo stands' were also set up on stage right (**SR**) and stage left (**SL**).

The solo and soli parts move to each of the solo stand at the following points:
